Ask 3 Questions

1. Is anyone in the home or business currently ill or experiencing flu-like symptoms including fever?
2. Has anyone in the home or business traveled internationally or on a cruise in the past 14 days?
3. Have you or anyone you've been in contact with been exposed or diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 14 days?



All Responses "No"

Proceed with Level 1 Guidance

- Must wear face mask at all times, use nitrile gloves when appropriate and change them frequently, at least after each job.
- Promptly and properly dispose of the gloves to prevent potential secondary contamination.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Avoid touching surfaces within the building wherever possible.
- Thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds at every opportunity.
- Without soap and water, use hand sanitizer that is at least 60% alcohol.
- Frequently wipe down electronics, tools, and equipment with a product that advertises as killing 99.9% of bacteria and viruses
- Avoid sharing pens. Consider carrying disposable pens and leave them with customers if they must sign anything.

Stop Work and Perform Pre-Job Safety Briefing



Proceed with Level II Guidance

- Follow Job Safety Analysis
- Required PPE
 - Nitrile gloves (inner)
 - Work gloves
 - Nitrile gloves (outer)
 - Tyvek suit
 - Over-boots
 - ANSI-Z87 safety goggles
 - Respirator
- Only carry in tools necessary
- Properly remove PPE after use
- Dispose of single-use items
- Mark and dispose of biohazard material accordingly
- Decontaminate tools and reusable PPE
- Wash hands

NOTE: If personnel are not equipped with proper PPE, training and certification (medical clearance and fit testing), a first responder or other external party may be utilized to make entry and perform the required task.
